# DID YOU REMEMBER THE BLUE ENVELOPE? It's for Per Capita Apportionment

#### What are Per Capita Payments?

Per Capita is an assessment to support the larger church, the Presbytery, Synod, and General Assembly. Each church is required to pay Per Capita based on the number of members on our church roll. If members don't send in their Per Capita, it is then paid out of the church's general funds.

The Per Capita amount for the year 2020 was approved by Presbytery at \$45. per member. However, if next year's Per Capita is paid before December 31, 2019, it will be due at the 2019 rate of \$40.35.

Session approved a motion to pay WAPC's Per Capita for 2020 at the current rate of \$40.35 per member before December 31, 2019, thereby saving \$325.50.

So look for the blue envelope labeled Per Capita in with your offering envelopes. If you haven't paid the amount of \$40.35 due for 2019, you still can. And if you pay Per Capita for 2020 early (before the end of this year), you can pay at the 2019 rate, saving yourself \$4.65.

If you don't have a blue envelope, just write Per Capita and Year 2019 or Year 2020 on the memo line of your check.

Remember, it is never too late to send in your Per Capita payment.



I want to thank those who gave of their time and energy on that VERY HOT October 2nd.



at 11 a.m. to knit or 10 a.m. to decorate.


Please keep this ministry of sharing God's love through shawls in your prayers, and remember to let one of our members know if there is a need for a shawl.
