- NORWESCAP, the non-profit agency that runs the WIC program, wants to rent additional space for a Career and Life Transitions Center. Dave Lyttle is getting further details. A stairlift to the basement will not be required.
- Plans were being finalized for the Live Nativity on December 15th.
- Elder Jim Roselli has volunteered to be on the Missional Structures Committee of the Presbytery (working on the new structure for New Jersey presbyteries).
- Session voted to buy five 5-gallon bottles of water to install in the water cooler in the Parish Hall, to assess the usage amount and replenish as needed. In late January, we will re-evaluate our needs.
- Committee chairs need to get budget requests to Elder Stambaugh, so he can develop the 2020 church budget.
- The next regular Session meeting will be on Monday, January 13, 2020.




